'Meet the Maths'

Mrs Rogers (Assistant Head and Maths Lead at Treloweth and across the Crofty MAT) organised the recent 'Meet the Maths' meetings to demonstrate to parents and carers how we teach mathematics at Treloweth. The meetings were a huge success and Mrs Rogers has provided a summary of the wonderful responses we received below.

- 60 parents attended (four year groups, Years 1, 3, 4 and 5)
- 51 responses
- 100% found the session useful
- 87% 'definitely' feel more confident in supporting their child at home; 13% 'mostly'
- 100% feel that seeing the maths resources used in school was helpful
- The most useful parts were:

"Seeing how lessons are delivered; finding out about resources; seeing how the children are challenged; finding out about reasoning; all of it!; repetition in lessons; explanations; understanding how fractions are taught; how to visualise fractions; resources to support at home; how my child does things; improving my understanding of fractions; understanding the curriculum."

- Parents felt that more sessions would be good... more next year!
