
Free School Meals reminder

Please don't forget, if your circumstances change and you think you might be eligible, you can apply to the Free School Meals team through the Cornwall Council website and complete the online application form. www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolmeals


For every child, you could receive £15 each week (2 children = £30, 3 children = £45 and so on). It really is worthwhile. By being eligible for Free School Meals your child becomes 'Pupil Premium'. Early signs from the Government suggests that money will be allocated to this group of children for priority catch up in September.

Mrs Roger's maths challenges


Maths puzzle from last week:
