'Treloweth Remembers' – Friday 9th November

2018 marks the centenary of the end of the First World War. To mark this, children will be learning about certain aspects of this conflict. We are asking children to wear an item of red – a scarf, jumper, hat – on Friday 9th November, and politely ask also if you could support The Royal British Legion in offering any loose change. The coins will be used to cover a giant poppy, with proceeds going towards their work in providing lifelong support for the Armed Forces community. We thank you in advance for any contributions you are able to make.

Heating Installation

On Monday 12th November, contractors will start work to replace one of our heating boilers. The work will be carried out in the Key Stage 1 playground and will work around drop off and pick up times. We are being given a temporary heating supply whilst this work is carried, and this is being delivered on Tuesday 13th November. This involves lifting a unit over the fence at the Happy Days Nursery end of the school.
