What a brilliant few weeks! We are thoroughly enjoying learning about dinosaurs and have immersed ourselves in writing, fact finding and creativity. We still have a week left on this theme and then we will move onto Traditional Tales. This EYFS letter will now become fortnightly as Mr Lawrence has been asked to edit the School Newsletter on alternate weeks.

Forest School – This half term Forest School will be run by Mrs Ishmael and Mrs Sciascia. Our Learning

English

- *Daily phonics and thinking activities,
- *Reading – each child will be heard to read by an adult every week,
- *Focus books – Dinosaur Roar! Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs, Saturday Night at the Dinosaur Stomp, Harry and the Dinosaurs say “RAAAHH”, Non – Fiction Books.
- *Writing – facts, labelling dinosaur body parts, recounts of stories, looking after dinosaur teeth.
- *Rhyming words.

Maths

- *Grouping and sorting,
- *Counting accurately,
- *Making and recognising teen numbers,
- *Weighing large dinosaurs with small dinosaurs – estimating and checking

Creative

- *Making a whole class display of a Jurassic World,
- *Paper plate Dinosaurs,
- *“ Tap Hammer” dinosaurs – using 2D shapes,
- *Dinosaur Eggs with playdough.
- *Free painting
