Our Learning Journey

Dear Parent / Carer

The children thoroughly enjoyed learning about dragons and dinosaurs. We created a super display outside our classrooms where all the children contributed. We are now learning about "Traditional Stories" and have started this week. On Monday we introduced the story of the "Three Little Pigs" and will base our learning around it. We will investigate different materials, write and adapt the story, build and learn about different types of homes and set a family homework project for half term.

Other stories that we will use after half term include "The Ginger Bread Man" and "Little Red Riding Hood".

Our Learning

English

- *Read Write Inc – daily phonics activities in small Groups,
- *Daily opportunities to think, speak and listen carefully,
- *Each child reads to an adult at least once a week,
- *Diary writing,
- *Recount of the Three Little Pigs, making a story map, telling the story using our maps, describing characters, wanted posters.
- *Handwriting and letter formation,
- *Spelling 3 letter words (CVC)

Maths

- *Finding one more or one less than a given number,
- *Combining two amounts to make a total,
- *Adding 2 numbers,
- *Using the vocabulary of addition,
- *Correct number formation.

Topic

- *Making a whole class "Three Little Pigs" display
- *Investigating materials – straw, sticks and bricks,
- *Building the strongest wall,
- *Role playing the story,
- *Making masks and lollipop characters from the story,
