I am very happy to be back at the helm of Treloweth again and have missed the community of staff, children and families.

Mr Callaway is now supporting the new Headteacher of Pennoweth School for the spring term. Mr Warren and Mrs Rogers, our Assistant Headteachers will further strengthen the leadership team here in Mr Callaway's absence and the cracking pastoral team of Mrs Stoddern, Mrs Walpole, Mr McCarthy and Mrs Richards will be on hand to support any worries or concerns that you or the children may have.

Additional and exciting news... Cornwall Council has identified a need for more primary school places in the Pool and Redruth areas, in order to meet increasing demand from population growth and housing development. After considering various options to create extra school places, the Council has approached Crofty Multi Academy Trust to propose expanding Treloweth Primary School by an additional 210 pupils (an extra 30 pupils per year group). Having met with Council officers to discuss these options, Crofty MAT and school Governors have agreed that we should pursue the proposals, which would ensure that our schools can continue to meet demand for school places from our local communities. Please note that the plans are at a very early stage and the next step will be to undertake consultation with our school community, including parents, staff and pupils, which is likely to take place later this term. The plans will also be required to complete the usual planning permission process.

The children have settled back into school life really well and we look forward to a productive, happy and enjoyable term!


